We sorted materials into solids, liquids and gases.



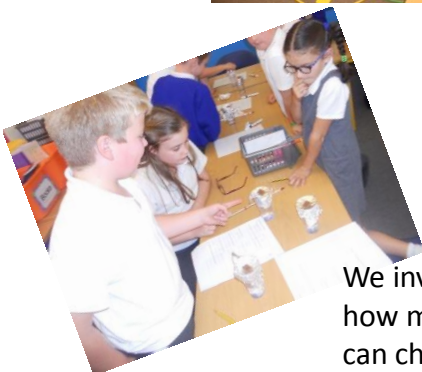
We became archeologists and dug for Ancient Egypt artefacts.
