### Forest Schools Week

**Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June** is our Forest School learning week. As Forest School coordinator at Weobley Primary School I thought it would be great to take part in some fun activities during this week.

I have, therefore, organised for the whole school to have a half day to enjoy some forest school activities, which an outside trained forest school leader will teach. We will be going over to our forest school area for these sessions and all activities have been risk assessed. For those of you who are not familiar with our forest school area, it is within close proximity to the school, over the high school playing field and into our designated forest schools area of woodland.

**All children** must bring in clothes suitable for forest school sessions. They will need warm clothes that may get muddy and wet; **trousers, extra fleece, extra socks, gloves, hat, waterproof coat (waterproof trousers if they have them) and wellies.** These clothes must be in addition to school uniform as they may get wet and muddy and will need a change of clothes.

We are joining forces with Rooted Forest School to try and obtain funding for a years worth of funding of Forest School activities for the next academic year.
